Did You Know?

Around 40% of all trauma-related deaths worldwide are due to bleeding.

Hemorrhage is the most common cause of preventable death in trauma.

A free 2-hour training can be the difference between life or death.

• An onsite class provided by Stop The Bleed experts can help you save someone else... or yourself, from bleeding to death.

Classes can be scheduled according to your district needs and can include as many employees as you want.

Uncontrolled bleeding can kill in as little as 5-10 minutes

• School nurses and other EMT qualified employees can also take the free train-the-trainer class, so you can continue training on your own.

• Free tourniquets are provided to districts once training is complete.
