BACK TO SCHOOL SAFETY:

TRAINING OPPORTUNITIES

Harry S. Truman once said:

"It's what you learn after you know it all that counts".

Don't forget to schedule your mandatory safety trainings!



Fire Safety:

All employees need annual training on the proper use of fire extinguishers, as well as general fire prevention.

Healthy Schools Act Training: This training is required for any employees who use antimicrobial sprays or wipes on school grounds. AB2260





Hazard Communication:

Every year all employees who have work exposures —even office workers that come into contact with chemicals in passing- must review procedures, Safety Data Sheet (SDS) access, and emergency response.



Blood-Borne Pathogens:

All employees who are reasonably anticipated to have contact with blood or other potentially infectious materials must be trained annually. The training can be an onsite or online class, discussion, and/or literature handouts to district employees.

There are additional topics that districts need training on to maintain a safe and secure school or worksite; different sites will have different priorities.
